- 6) I was the Saint Ann's church building before the current location at 82 Shore Road.
- 7) I am a favorite dining spot for chickadees, downy woodpeckers and house finches.
- 8) I am over forty feet high and sit atop a building, placed there by a crane five years after the building was constructed in the early sixties.
- 9) I am to the right of the Saint Ann's building as you face it, and provide fresh produce for those who need it.
