### Objectives of the Narcan Training

1. To provide information to youth about the dangers of opioid use, as well as the rise in fentanyl in fake prescription pills.
2. Teach youth how to identify signs of an overdose.
3. How and when to administer an opioid antagonist (i.e Narcan/Naloxone)
4. The proper steps for contacting emergency services and maintain safety should an overdose occur in their presence. Naloxone is an opioid antagonist that will temporarily reverse an overdose brought on by opioids. It is a lifesaving medication that can reverse an overdose long enough for emergency services to arrive on scene.
